School Contacts for Attendance

Create an environment that encourages education

- ✓ Establish a daily routine
- ✓ Set a regular time for homework
- ✓ Ask to see classwork
- ✓ Establish a study area
- ✓ Ask about their day
- ✓ Help your child set goals

Get Involved

- ✓ Attend open house
- ✓ Contact teachers
- ✓ Work with the school when issues come up
- ✓ Volunteer
- ✓ Attend after school activities with your child

Be familiar with Attendance Policies and Procedures

- ✓ Access and track attendance on the IC Parent Portal
- ✓ Provide notes to the school
- ✓ Turn notes in within school's timeframe
- ✓ Clarify where notes are to be submitted
- ✓ Contact Attendance clerk regularly to confirm records

Be Firm about school attendance

- ✓ Arrive on time
- ✓ Schedule appointments outside of school day
- ✓ Use school breaks for vacations and appointments
- ✓ Pick up assignments when absent
- ✓ Make sure contact information is up-to-date
